RECITALS:

- a. DOP, on behalf of the State of Idaho (State), has a current Contract (PADD#20221028) with Computer Aid, Inc. for IT Vendor Managed Services that will expire on 08/31/2022.
- b. The State of Connecticut is preparing a Request for Proposal (RFP) through NASPO Value Point to replace the current Master Agreement.
- c. This is a critical service for the State and continuing services with the current Contractor for an additional nine (9) months or until a new Master Agreement and PADD are in place, is in the best interest of the State.
- d. Pursuant to Idaho Code, Section 67-9221 and IDAPA 38.05.01.042.09 DOP has approved a one-time exemption from competition to allow for continuation of these critical services.

AGREEMENT:

THE CONTRACTOR AGREES TO UNDERTAKE PERFORMANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH HEREIN. THE PARTIES, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL COVENANTS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED HEREIN, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide a ‘bridge agreement’ allowing the Contractor to continue to provide the IT Vendor Managed Services during the solicitation, award and implementation of a new Connecticut Master Agreement and Idaho PADD. The term shall be 09/01/2022 – 05/31/2023 or until a new Mater Agreement and PADD are in place.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The Contractor shall continue to provide IT Vendor Managed Services during the term of this agreement per the original terms of the Connecticut Master Agreement #14PSX0338AB and PADD #20221028.

3. PAYMENTS

The State of Idaho will make payments per the terms of Connecticut Master Agreement #14PSX0338AB and State of Idaho PADD #20221028 and as included herein.

4. SR. CONSULTANT RATE CARD

The Senior Consultant is familiar with a variety of information technology-related concepts, methodologies, practices, and procedures and relies on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals. Sr. Consultants perform a variety of complicated tasks with minimal or no direct supervision. They will be able to define systems and application architecture and provide vision, problem anticipation, and problem-solving ability to agencies. Sr. Consultants work with agencies to define needs or problems, conducts research, performs studies and surveys to obtain data, and analyzes problems to advise on or recommend solutions, utilizing knowledge of theory, principles, or technology of specific discipline or field of specialization. Agencies that intend to utilize the Sr. Consultant Rate Card must provide a justification to DOP and receive written permission prior to completing the Project Service Order (PSO).

5. INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE


